

Allee Elm

Ulmus chinensis 'Allee'



- 🍃 **Form:** Upright rounded
- 🍃 **Growth Rate:** Average
- 🍃 **Drought Tolerance:** High
- 🍃 **Size:** 50-60' tall 35-40' wide
- 🍃 **Zone:** 5-9
- 🍃 **Salt Tolerance:** Moderate

Light Requirements: Full sun to partial shade

Soil Requirements: Well-drained, moist, fertile, humus rich, slightly alkaline to slightly acidic soil, very adaptable to clay, loam, or sandy soils

Bark: Smooth; olive brownish gray when young; exfoliates puzzle-like bark exposing orange, tan, gray, and brown patches

Flower: Small, light green to reddish green flowers in axillary clusters; inconspicuous; blooms late summer to early fall

Fruit: Green or brown, flat, membranous samara seed in middle.

Foliage: Alternate, simple, elliptical to ovate and leathery with simple to crenate round, serration; bright green leaves turn yellow to bronze in the fall

Uses: Street tree, parking lots, medians, lawn tree, shade tree, planters, specimen, standard or multi-trunk
