

# Bosque Elm

*Ulmus parvifolia* UPMTF



- 🍃 **Form:** Upright, round crown
- 🍃 **Size:** 50-60' tall X 30-35' Wide
- 🍃 **Growth Rate:** Fast
- 🍃 **Zone:** 5-9
- 🍃 **Drought Tolerance:** Moderate
- 🍃 **Salt Tolerance:** Moderate

**Light Requirements:** Full sun

**Soil Requirements:** Well-drained

**Bark:** The bark is wonderful with irregular fluting forming deep creases from the soil line to the canopy. The bark is often multi-colored. Mottled bark revealing patches of gray, cream, orange, brown, and green.

**Flower:** Insignificant, small, reddish-green flowers late summer

**Fruit:** Single-seed wafer-like samaras

**Foliage:** Elliptic to ovate, shiny dark green leaves having small teeth. Leaves usually turn yellow to orange in fall.

**Uses:** Works well has a lawn, shade, or street tree.
