

Bur Oak

Quercus macrocarpa



- 🍃 **Form:** Symmetrical
- 🍃 **Growth Rate:** Fast
- 🍃 **Drought Tolerance:** High
- 🍃 **Size:** 70-90' tall by 60-80' wide
- 🍃 **Zone:** 3-8
- 🍃 **Salt Tolerance:** High

Light Requirements: Full sun

Soil Requirements: Clay; loam; sand; acidic; alkaline; well-drained; extended flooding

Bark: light gray with thick, rough, deeply furrowed scaly ridges

Flower: inconspicuous and not showy; brown

Fruit: Oval; 1-3"; ½" to 1"; dry hard brown; causes litter; showy

Foliage: alternate, simple, lobed obovate pinnate, 8-12" by 4-8" green copper

Uses: Street tree, large specimen tree, parking lots, parks. Not suitable to be planted in lawn strips less than 10' wide.
