## Ulmus crassifolia



Form: Round Vase Shape

**Size:** 50-70' tall by 40-60' wide

Growth Rate: ModerateDrought Tolerance: High

Zone: 6-9Salt Tolerance: Moderate

Light Requirements: Full sun can tolerate partial shade

Soil Requirements: Clay; loam; sand; acidic; alkaline; extended

flooding; well-drained

**Bark:** Scaly and drooping branches with corky ridges **Flower:** Green fall flowering; inconspicuous not showy

Fruit: Oval 1-3" 1/2"-1" dry hard

**Foliage:** Alternate, simple, crenate, double serrate; elliptical; obovate; pinnate, less than 2" green turning yellow in the fall **Uses:** Large parking lot islands, wide tree lawns, medium-sized parking lot islands, buffer strips around parking lots; median strips, reclamation plant; shade tree, residential street tree
