

Cedar Elm

Ulmus crassifolia



- 🍃 **Form:** Round Vase Shape
- 🍃 **Size:** 50-70' tall by 40-60' wide
- 🍃 **Growth Rate:** Moderate
- 🍃 **Zone:** 6-9
- 🍃 **Drought Tolerance:** High
- 🍃 **Salt Tolerance:** Moderate

Light Requirements: Full sun can tolerate partial shade

Soil Requirements: Clay; loam; sand; acidic; alkaline; extended flooding; well-drained

Bark: Scaly and drooping branches with corky ridges

Flower: Green fall flowering; inconspicuous not showy

Fruit: Oval 1-3" ½"-1" dry hard

Foliage: Alternate, simple, crenate, double serrate; elliptical; obovate; pinnate, less than 2" green turning yellow in the fall

Uses: Large parking lot islands, wide tree lawns, medium-sized parking lot islands, buffer strips around parking lots; median strips, reclamation plant; shade tree, residential street tree
