Magnolia grandiflora 'Claudia Wannamaker'



Form: PyramidalGrowth Rate: Fast

Drought Tolerance: High

Light Requirements: Full sun

Size: 50-60' tall by 30-40' wide

Zone: 7-10

Salt Tolerance: Moderate

Soil Requirements: Well-drained, moist, fertile, humus rich soil

that is well-limed; tolerant of slightly acidic soil **Bark:** Smooth; grayish brown to blackish gray

Flower: Fragrant, white flowers are 6-8" wide; blooms May to

June; attracts insects

Fruit: Red berries in a large, hard woody cone, sometimes

considered messy

Foliage: Alternate, simple, ovate to elliptica, 5-10" long; medium green leaves with tannish brown underside; older, inner leaves turn yellow to brown and shed in Fall and again in Spring as new growth begins; leaf litter can be messy

Uses: Lawn tree, specimen plant, naturalizing, screening, buffer

strips in parking lots and median planting
