



## Claudia Wannamaker Magnolia

*Magnolia grandiflora* 'Claudia Wannamaker'



- 🍃 **Form:** Pyramidal
- 🍃 **Growth Rate:** Fast
- 🍃 **Drought Tolerance:** High
- 🍃 **Size:** 50-60' tall by 30-40' wide
- 🍃 **Zone:** 7-10
- 🍃 **Salt Tolerance:** Moderate

**Light Requirements:** Full sun

**Soil Requirements:** Well-drained, moist, fertile, humus rich soil that is well-limed; tolerant of slightly acidic soil

**Bark:** Smooth; grayish brown to blackish gray

**Flower:** Fragrant, white flowers are 6-8" wide; blooms May to June; attracts insects

**Fruit:** Red berries in a large, hard woody cone, sometimes considered messy

**Foliage:** Alternate, simple, ovate to elliptical, 5-10" long; medium green leaves with tannish brown underside; older, inner leaves turn yellow to brown and shed in Fall and again in Spring as new growth begins; leaf litter can be messy

**Uses:** Lawn tree, specimen plant, naturalizing, screening, buffer strips in parking lots and median planting
