

Debonair Pond Cypress

Taxodium ascendens 'Debonair'



- 🍃 **Form:** Narrow oval
- 🍃 **Growth Rate:** Moderate
- 🍃 **Drought Tolerance:** Moderate
- 🍃 **Size:** 50' tall by 10-12' wide
- 🍃 **Zone:** 5a
- 🍃 **Salt Tolerance:** Moderate

Light Requirements: Full sun

Soil Requirements: Adapts well to most soil types, adapts well to wet areas, prefers low pH

Bark: Reddish brown, interesting exfoliating

Flower: N/A

Fruit: Brown round cone

Foliage: Needled conifer that has erect branchlets of bright green fern like needles. Turns bronze, orange in the fall

Screen, specimen, street tree, large parking lot islands, parking lot buffer strips. Good for urban areas; great to use in parking lots or medians; Cypress knees do not appear when planted in drier locations, but when growing in saturated soils conditions, knees may be produced.
