

Dura Heat River Birch Betula nigra 'BNMTF'



Form: Upright Oval Growth Rate: Fast

Drought Tolerance: Low

Light Requirements: Full sun to partial shade

Soil Requirements: Well-drained, moist, fertile, humus rich soil;

Zone: 4-9

Salt Tolerance: Low

very tolerant of most sites

Bark: Smooth; greenish brown when young; matures bark exfoliates in large, papery sheets with a gray brown to chalky tan

to beige color

Flower: Catkins, 2-4" long; blooms in Spring

Fruit: Nutlet produced in Spring

Foliage: Alternate, simple; medium to dark green, serrated

leaves turn shade of yellow in Fall

Uses: Specimen tree, buffer areas, lawns, parks, as a Winter

Accent with bark interest and reclamation planting
