October Glory Maple

Acer rubrum



- 🍂 **Form:** Oval rounded
- 🍂 **Size:** 40-50' tall by 25-35' wide
- 🍂 **Growth Rate:** Moderate
- 🍂 **Zone:** 5-8
- 🍂 **Drought Tolerance:** Moderate
- 🍂 **Salt Tolerance:** Low

Light Requirements: Full sun to partial shade

Soil Requirements: Well-drained, moist, fertile, humus rich, slightly acidic soil; tolerates wet sites

Bark: Smooth; grayish tan and develops shallow fissures, ridges, and plates when mature

Flower: Greenish yellow; blooms in Spring

Fruit: Somewhat red, winged samara

Foliage: Opposite, simple, medium-sized, five-lobed; green to dark green leaves in summer turn orange, red, or purple in Fall

Uses: Large shade tree, street tree, specimen tree, group planting, buffer, and naturalizing

Very adaptable to urban growing sites; moderately tolerant of air pollutants, compacted soil, and moderately dry planting sites.

Most widely grown and planted for consistent plant growth, form, and Fall coloration.
