

Pond Cypress Taxodium ascendens



**Form:** Pyramidal

Growth Rate: Slow

- **Size:** 30' tall by 50-60' wide
- 🖉 Zone: 5a-9b

Drought Tolerance: Moderate Salt Tolerance: Moderate Light Requirements: Full sun

**Soil Requirements:** Adapts well to most soil types, adapts well to wet areas, prefers low pH

Bark: Reddish brown, interesting exfoliating

Flower: N/A

Fruit: Brown round cone

**Foliage:** Needled conifer that has erect branchlets of bright green fern like needles. Turns bronze, orange in the fall **Uses:** Screen, specimen, street tree, large parking lot islands, parking lot buffer stirps. Good for urban areas; great to use in parking lots or medians; Cypress knees do not appear when planted in drier locations, but when growing in saturated soils conditions, knees may be produced
