

Shawnee Brave Bald Cypress

Taxodium distichum 'Mickelson'



Form: Narrow pyramidal

Growth Rate: Fast

Drought Tolerance: High

Light Requirements: Full sun

Size: 55-75' tall by 18-20' wide

Zone: 5-9

Salt Tolerance: High

Soil Requirements: Adaptable to most soils except highly alkaline; If the pH is too high, the leaves will become chlorotic and turn yellow

Bark: Smooth; reddish brown fibers when young; matures to reddish brown to gray, brown with shallow fissures; ridges are narrow strips, ribbon and bands vertically overlapping.

Flower: Monoecious, purple male catkins, green female cones; inconspicuous

Fruit: Small, round cones, clusters mature October -

December

Foliage: Green foliage turns russet-brown to orange, brown in the fall; soft feathery needles

Large parking lot islands, parking lot buffer strips, reclamation plantings, screening and as a shade tree; can be clipped into a nice soft hedge
