Juniperus virginiana



Form: Upright Narrow

Growth Rate: Fast

Soil Requirements: Adaptable but will thrive best in average solid that is somewhat moist. Needs well-draining soil.

Foliage: The dense semi-soft, blue green foliage.

Narrow landscape accent/specimen. Flank entrances. Large screen or windbreak. The natural form of the cultivar is tall, slender, and columnar with a pyramidal taper, the exact shape you would want from a coniferous evergreen hedge. Pruning may disrupt the cultivar's natural form.
