

Texas Ash

Fraxinus texensis



Form: Upright Symmetrical

Growth Rate: Slow

Drought Tolerance: High

Light Requirements: Full sun

Soil Requirements: Clay; sand; loam; alkaline; acidic; occasionally

Size: 30-40' tall by 25-35' wide

Zone: 5a-9a

Salt Tolerance: N/A

wet; well-drained

Bark: Gray with brown or black blotches, furrowed, with the interlocking flattened ridges common to the ashes on older trunks.

Flower: Green and not showy

Fruit: Round .5 to 1" dry or hard pink does not attract wildlife; showy; fruit/leaves not a litter problem

Foliage: Opposite/subopposite; odd-pinnately compound; serrate, entire; ovate, obovate; pinnate, reticulate, deciduous less than 2" green with orange, red, purple showy fall color. City street and parking lot tree, shade tree, deck or patio, specimen.
