

# Texas Red Oak

*Quercus buckleyi*



🍃 **Form:** Narrow Round

🍃 **Growth Rate:** Fast

🍃 **Drought Tolerance:** High

🍃 **Size:** 30-75' tall by 25-50' wide

🍃 **Zone:** 5-9

🍃 **Salt Tolerance:** Low

**Light Requirements:** Full sun

**Soil Requirements:** Clay; loam; sand; alkaline; acidic; well-drained

**Bark:** Dark gray to black with platelike scales, although sometimes it is light gray and smooth

**Flower:** Inconspicuous and not showy; brown; spring flowering

**Fruit:** Oval; round; ½" to 1"; dry hard brown; causes litter; not showy

**Foliage:** Alternate, simple, lobed; parted elliptic; obovate; pinnate 4-8" green turning orange and red in the Fall

Large parking lot islands, wide tree lawns, buffer strips around parking lots, median strips, reclamation plant, shade tree, specimen, residential street tree
