## Cercis canadensis var texensis 'Texas White'



Form: Round Upright

Growth Rate: Fast

**Drought Tolerance:** Moderate **Salt Tolerance:** Moderate

Light Requirements: Full sun to partial shade

**Size:** 20' tall by 20' wide

**Zone**: 6

Soil Requirements: Adaptable to both dry and moist locations Bark: Older sandy brown bark exfoliates to reveal orangish inner bark.

Flower: Pea-like flowers along branches from early to mid-spring, which emerge from distinctive creamy white flower buds before the leaves.

Fruit: No Fruit

Foliage: Small glossy heart shaped dark green leaves that turn

vellow in the fall.

Accent, mass planting, garden use. A wonderful small accent tree covered with elegant white flowers in early spring.
